

Finding the heart rate monitor device number



The heart rate monitor “device number”

Each heart rate monitor has a unique identifier built-in

The identifier is a number that it is uniquely assigned to each heart rate monitor

Some heart rate monitors have the identifier written on the monitor itself

Selfloops HRM

You can find the device number
on top left



Polar HRM

You can find the
device number on top



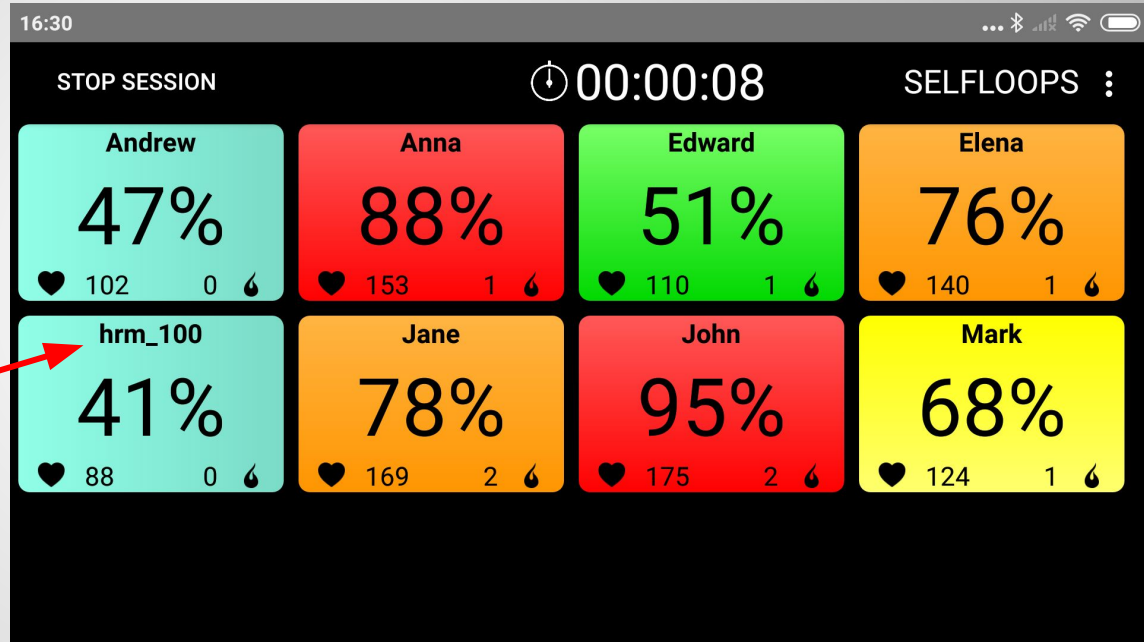
Android - where to find the device number (1/3)

Wear a HRM

Start the application

As tiles appear on the screen, for unregistered users the app will show the ID on the tile. ID is 100 in the image

For registered users, just tap the tile for more info.



Android - where to find the device number (2/3)

Tap the tile, a new window opens, tap edit.

The HR dev number is the device ID.

How to associate users to HRMs

The device number must be associated to a user

Once the association is made, every time a person will wear that heart rate monitor, our application will automatically recognize him

This must only be done once
