

Finding the sensor device number



The sensor “device number”

Each sensor, such as a heart rate monitor or a bike, has a unique built-in identifier.

This identifier is a distinct number assigned to each sensor.

In some cases, the identifier is printed directly on the equipment.

SELFLOOPS HRM

You can find the device number on the top left of the sensor, in this case the ID is 373

The leading 0s must be removed



Polar HRM

The device number is located on top of the sensor.

Polar IDs include both letters and numbers. Please ensure you use uppercase letters.

An example of Polar ID is 62FFCC13



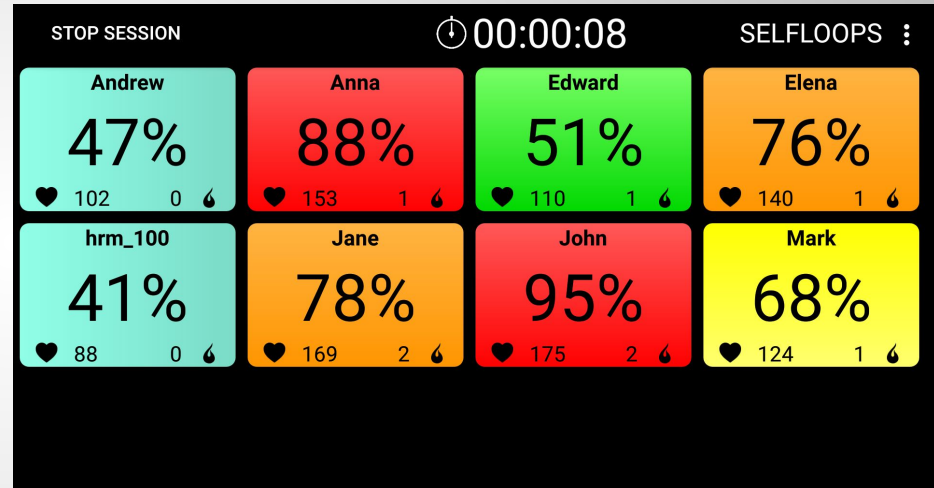
How to find the device number

Sensors that do not have an associated user will appear as hrm_ID on the screen.

hrm stands for heart rate monitor and ID is the sensor unique identification number.

In the image the sensor ID is 100

Make sure to register and associate the sensor to a user in the Equipment section of the website and then perform a user synchronization or class sync (if you use classes).
